During his tenure he has coached several Atlantic Junior Champions and seen many of his players represent their individual provinces at Canada Games. He has also worked with a number of players who have gone on to scholarships in the NCAA. Mark has spent time as New Brunswick Provincial Coach and Touring Coach for the Atlantic Tennis Alliance. Since beginning his stint in New Brunswick, Mark has coached 16 players to National Championship spots, 14 Canada Games Team Members and 3 players with rankings in the top 20 in Canada including Mathieu Girouard who reached number 3 in 2006.

As a player, Mark is a four time New Brunswick Open Champion in doubles and mixed doubles and two time NB Provincial Champion, and has held the number 1 Provincial Ranking in both events.

As a graduate of Saint Francis Xavier University, Mark holds a full time teaching position at Amherst Regional High School where he is a member of the Science Department. He lives in Sackville, NB with his wife Sara and their son Nathaniel.
